- Education: to prepare children to be school ready for kindergarten
- Developmental Screens: to meet the individual needs of the child.
- Health: Help children be healthy
- Nutrition: provide healthy meals and snacks
- Mental Health: address children's emotional health
- Special Needs: support children's disability needs
- Family: help parents enhance their strengths and help in times of need
- Parent engagement: encourage families to be active in their child's education.
- Community Partnerships: assist families with community resources.
- Family Fun Nights: celebrating family and friendships.
- Transition: activities to prepare children and families for kindergarten
